i) IN THE BOROUGH ITSELF

Neolithic/Bronze age flint blade-tools. Found at Maiden's Bower. c144800

Flint flake. Found at Shirley, perhaps near the Mount. ?130761

Late Neolithic short necked Beaker, type N3. From a gravel pit. Clinch (1904), p 222; Clarke (1970), no 1013, but probably wrongly given to Lillington. Meriden. none

Two late Bronze age bronze swords, Ewart Park type. From a group of four, the others lost. Bloxham (1878), p 35; Shotton (1938), pp 190-1, fig 2. Meriden. c2481

Neolithic Bronze age, flint barbed and tanged arrowhead, and flakes. Found at Long Meadow Farm, Burton Green. Shotton (1937), p49. Kenilworth. 267756

Middle Bronze age bronze looped palstave. Found at Burton Green. Hodgkinson (1944), p 107; Humphreys (1949). Kenilworth. 2675

Neolithic axe, white porous stone; ? ethnographical specimen. Northfield 0379

Neolithic axe, group VI. Found at Tessel Lane/Elan Road junction. Northfield. 00527859

Middle Bronze age bronze palstave, loopless, central rib. Found 1939, 186 Flaxley Road. Stechford. 13478763

Neolithic axe (group VII), 'Found when making Bond Street, Bourneville, August 1899, in gravel, old bed of river. Evans, Grinsell, Piggot and Wallis (1962), p 263, no 1075; Gunstone (1967), p 95, fig 2C. 05258130

- Late Neolithic/early Bronze age flint tanged 09279120

- Unfinished (ie unperforated) axe-hammer (22/ah; group XIV). 30507915  
Found at 190 Greendale Road, Whoberlay Hall. Coventry.
- Fragmented axe-hammer (15/ah), (group XIV). Found at 315775  
4, Innes Road. Shotton (1959), p 136. Coventry.

used in the Coventry pageants and possibly found near Pageant  
House, Cox Street. Coventry.

- Iron age gold coin, Gallo-Belgic E. Found at 100 Beake Avenue. Allen (1958), p 166. Coventry. 326818
- Neolithic/Bronze age flint trimmed point. Found at the sewage works. Shotton (1933), p 66, fig 16k; Shotton (1937), p 50. Coventry. 3334741
- Neolithic/Bronze age small, plain, cylindrical (?) Incense Cup. Found while drain-digging at Kings Hill. Edwards (1932), p 46, fig 11. 3274
- Neolithic/early Bronze age axe-hammer (5/ah; group XIV). Found at a farm, used as a weight for a head-stall rope. Shotton (1959), p 136. c3582
- Neolithic/Bronze age flint scraper. Hearsall Common. c3178
- Neolithic flint leaf-shaped arrowhead. Found at 38, Lynmouth Road. Henley Green. 370817
- Neolithic/early Bronze age axe-hammer (23/ah; Greywacke). Found while building an air-raid shelter at Stonebrook Fields, 1939. Longford. 3582
- Neolithic polished flint axe (2/cf). Found 5 ft below the surface when well-digging, 1919. Shotton (1937), 44-5. Pinley. 3577
- Neolithic/early Bronze age axe-hammer (4/ah; group XIV). Found while digging drains. Evans (1897), 177-8, fig 130; Shotton (1937), 46; Shotton (1959), 136. 380810
- Middle Bronze age flanged bronze axe. Found 3 ft deep, 500 yds SW of Catholic Chapel at Whitley Abbey, 1930. Edwards (1932), p 46; Sanders (1932). Whitley. 34707635



- Middle Bronze age bronze socketed spear-head. Found on med. 280868  
earthwork called the Butts. 1961. Fillongley.
  
- Neolithic/Bronze age fragmented axe (10/c). Butt only, 7314719  
found before 1876, between Ham (or Hom ?) Hill and  
Kenilworth Castle. Burgess (1876), p 371; Burgess (1878)  
Clinch (1904), p 222; Shotton (1937), p 45.
  
- Neolithic/Bronze age flint barbed and tanged arrowheads. 29337273  
Found in Odibourne Allotments. Kenilworth.
  
- Neolithic/Bronze age flint flakes and implements. Found 340723  
in plough soil, Stoneleigh Park. Kenilworth.
  
- Iron age gold coin (Mack 52-3). Found in Kenilworth area, 2872  
circa 1890. Allen (1963), p 15, no 212. Kenilworth.
  
- Neolithic Flint implement. Brodie (1893), p 11. 2069  
Rowington.
  
- Neolithic beaker potsherd, type no N3? Found at Ryton 7395741  
Grange. Clarke (1970), no 1015. Ryton-on-Dunsmore.
  
- Neolithic/early Bronze age flint, leaf-shaped arrowhead, 34007455  
scrapers and flakes. Found at Gibbet Hill, Stoneleigh.
  
- Flint leaf-shaped arrowhead, scrapers and flakes. Found in 30907477  
garden on N side of Stoneleigh Road and W of railway line.

- Axe (9/c;group VII), found 1100 yds SE of Gibbet Hill, 1933. 31207410  
Wright and Shotton (1935); Shotton (1937), p 44; Shotton

- Perforated disc (12/ah; group XV), Found at SE edge of Crackley wood, N of railway line, 1953. Shotton (1959), p 139. Stoneleigh. 29057403
- Flint implement found at Cryfield Grange Road. Shotton, (1937), p 49. Stoneleigh. 30367464
- Frag. battle axe (17/ah group XIV). Found near Stoneleigh Abbey. Rowe (1966), p 238, no 216. 3171
- Rough flint flakes and implements. Found at S corner of Coventry/Gibbet Hill cross roads. Shotton (1933), p 66. 30757455
- Flint scraper found at Manor Farm. Stoneleigh. 329726
- Miniature vessel, Found while drain-digging at Kings Hill, Finham. Edwards (1932), p 46. Stoneleigh. 32907467
